

Cookie Policy

This cookie policy relates to our use of ‘cookies’ in connection with this website.

By using our website, you agree to us placing cookies on your computer, smartphone or other device. This policy contains what you need to know about cookies, how and why we use them and how to manage or delete cookies in your browser

Definitions and interpretation

In this Policy the following terms shall have the following meanings:

“Data”

means collectively all information that you submit to Evolution Insurance Company Limited via the Website. This definition shall where applicable, incorporate the definitions provided in the Data Protection Act 2018;

“Cookie”

means a small text file placed on your computer by this Website when you visit certain parts of the Website and/or when you use certain features of the Website. Cookies alone cannot be used to identify you and the cookie itself does not keep any of the data it collects;

“EU Cookie Law”

means the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003 as amended by the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) (Amendment) Regulations 2011;

“User”

Means any third party that accesses the Website and is not employed by Evolution Insurance Company Limited and acting in the course of their employment; and

“Website”

means the Website that you are currently using (www.evo-insurance.com) and any sub-domains of this site unless expressly excluded by their own terms and conditions.

Cookies

This Website may place and access certain Cookies on your computer. Evolution Insurance Company Limited uses Cookies to improve your experience of using the Website and to improve our range of insurance products and services. Evolution Insurance Company Limited has carefully chosen these Cookies and has taken steps to ensure that your privacy is protected and always respected.

All Cookies used by this Website are used in accordance with Evolution Insurance Company Limited’s Privacy Notice and current EU Cookie Law.

Before the Website places any Cookies on your computer, you will be presented with a pop-up requesting your consent to set those Cookies. By giving your consent to the placing of Cookies you are enabling Evolution Insurance Company Limited to provide the best possible experience and service to you. You may, if you wish, deny consent to the placing of Cookies; however certain features of the Website may not function fully or as intended.

This Website uses analytics services. Website analytics refers to a set of tools used to collect and analyse usage statistics, enabling us to better understand how Users use the Website. This, in turn, enables us to improve the Website and the products and/or services offered through it. You do not have to allow us to use these Cookies, as detailed below, however whilst our use of them does not pose any risk to your privacy or your safe use of the Website it does enable us to continually improve our business.

Types of Cookie We Use

Necessary – These cookies are essential, and ensure our website works for you. The information these cookies collect is anonymous and they can't track your browser activity on other websites.

Performance / Analytical – These cookies collect information about how you use our website, like which pages you go to most often, how long you stay on them and if you get error messages. They don't collect information that can identify you – we only use them to improve how our website works.

How Long Cookies Last

Session Cookies – These are temporary and are deleted every time you close your browser.

Persistent Cookies – These stay on your computer until they expire or until you delete them from your device's cache.
